Since universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machine and are a lot less vulnerable to damage. These buckets are likewise 50 percent deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads like tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.

Quick-Tach forklift buckets can be utilized to swap the carriage and forks that weigh between 100-700lbs. Once installed, these buckets free up more of the unit's load capacity, enabling it to handle heavier and bigger things. The Quick-Tach is able to pour items about 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket.
