Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the blade carriage hoisting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is about thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
